IMPORTANT INFORMATION

2023 Citrus Sculptures

Construction Day - 7:30am Sunday 8 October 2023

Dismantle Day - 7:30am Sunday 22 October 2023

- All old rubber bands **MUST** be removed from the sculptures prior to Construction Day. Please return any unused bags of rubber bands to the Griffith Tourism Hub after Construction Day.
- For safety reasons, you **MUST** notify your area inductor of the amount of steel pegs installed with your sculpture on Construction Day. On Dismantle Day, you are required to confirm with your area inductor prior to leaving that you have removed all pegs from the sculpture site.
- **Only vehicles delivering sculptures are permitted to be in the sculptures site.** Vehicles must vacate the site as soon as the sculpture has been delivered.
- Area inductors and staff have the right to advise any vehicles to be removed from the site throughout the event.
- While within the sculpture site vehicles must have hazard lights on and not exceed 5km/h speed.
- Forklifts will be moving on site to drop bins of oranges to each area. Please be patient with the volunteer forklift drivers as they endeavour to distribute the bins evenly to all sculptures.
- Please ensure your organisation has enough volunteers to manually move your sculptures frame to it's designated area. Do not rely on forklift drivers to move your sculpture for you.
- It is encouraged you bring your own buckets to utilise in carrying oranges between the large orange bins and your sculpture.
- If required, you must provide your own ladder/s. Please contact the Events Coordinator prior to Construction Day if your sculpture is higher than 2m to discuss a safe system of construction to prevent falls from height.



2023 SCULPTURE REGULATIONS

2023 Citrus Sculptures

Please note, all businesses who include a Citrus Sculpture in Griffith Spring Fest in 2023 must adhere to the following regulations:

- All new sculpture designs and sculpture adjustments need to be approved by the Griffith Tourism Team.
- 90% of your sculpture MUST be citrus.
- Your sculpture must be 3D
- Branding is not allowed on the sculptures. If you have an existing sculpture with branding, please advise the Events Coordinator who can liaise with you on how to remove this. Signage identifying your business / organisation will be provided.
- Your structure must be engineered to be stable, withstand climatic elements and safe from trip hazards. If you have changed your existing structure in any way, please notify the Events Coordinator to ensure all changes are approved prior to construction.
- No boring of holes into the lawn will be permitted. Pegs are to be secured into the lawn at a maximum of 300mm deep.
- All structures are to be made from square mesh and not chook wire. If you are unsure of what materials to use, contact the Events Coordinator for an example.
- The Citrus Sculptures are a trademark from the Menton Lemon Festival. As Griffith has received permission to hold the event, all sculptures are under this agreement. Businesses are not to use their sculpture outside of Griffith Spring Fest without prior written authorisation from the Working Group.
